WHAT IS A WORK ACCIDENT?

An accident at work is a sudden event which, for whatever reason, causes physical or psychological injury and which occurs during a **professional activity**.

TWO DIFFERENT CASES

You did not received treatment or only light treatment with no external consultation afterwards = begnin accident.

It will be recorded on the benign accident register.

CASE 1

Following your accident at work, you had an external consultation requiring treatment or a sick leave. You must inform the HR department within 24 hours so that a declaration of accident can be made to the Social Security.

CASE 2

The HR department will systematically send a work accident declaration to the Social Security.
